Where Should I Start?

- Library's licensed images.
- Images with built-in permissions statements (Creative Commons).

Guidelines for Using Images

- Find an image with clearly stated terms of use that you can meet.
- Attach the URL for future reference.
- Match the image size to its use.
- Cite the owner of the image and the permission agreement
- Don't forget the caption

 - Password of your choice
 - Saves Up to 100 images
 - Download saved images in bulk
- Drug Index: lots of images, NOT included in the images search
