## Where Should I Start?

- Library's licensed images.
- Images with built-in permissions statements (Creative Commons).

## Guidelines for Using Images

- Find an image with clearly stated terms of use that you can meet.
- Attach the URL for future reference.
- Match the image size to its use.
- Cite the owner of the image and the permission agreement
- Don't forget the caption

Licensed by KU Med Libraries.</li></ul> <p><b>Additional features</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• My Saved Images<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Create (yet another) account</li><li>• Username <b>without</b> "@kumc.edu"</li><li>• Password of your choice</li><li>• Saves Up to 100 images</li><li>• Download saved images in bulk</li></ul></li><li>• Drug Index: lots of images, NOT included in the images search</li></ul>	<p><b>Creative Commons</b> <a href="http://creativecommons.org">http://creativecommons.org</a></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Popular content sites</li><li>• Creators have agreed to share royalty-free</li><li>• "Some rights-reserved" approach</li><li>• Easy</li></ul>	<p><b>PHIL (Public Health Image Library)</b> <a href="http://phil.cdc.gov/Phil/home.asp">http://phil.cdc.gov/Phil/home.asp</a></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Content:</b> photos, illustrations, video</li><li>• <b>Source:</b> CDC</li><li>• <b>Use:</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Most images are "Public Domain" (free use).</li><li>• Cite the <b>Content Provider</b></li><li>• Some are "Copyright Protected" (restricted, obtain permission before use)</li></ul></li></ul>
